




Amphibian Demonstration Pond Update – Enzo Bertucci





- Dufferin has partnered with Ministry of Natural Resources, Conservation Halton, and Credit Valley Conservation Authority to construct demonstration amphibian ponds on our lands.
- 2 ponds have been designed with the intent that they will be suitable JESA habitat ponds.
- Construction of ponds is imminent.



Joint Agency Review Team (JART) Process Update – Enzo Bertucci

- Dufferin has continued to meet with members of JART and their peer reviewers in order to work through technical issues related to application.
- Progress has been made over the last few months on a number of the technical disciplines.
- JART has provided clearance and conditional clearance letters on the following:
 - Archaeology and Cultural Landscape
 - Noise and Blasting
 - Air Quality
- We are very close but still awaiting a final position from JART on the following:
 - Water and AMP
 - Natural Environment
 - Transportation
 - Visual Impact Assessment
 - Agricultual Impact
- We are still working towards a final JART report release date by end of this year.
